If it happen that they do not make their personale appearance before the Justices of his Lordship County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer unto his said Lordship & and if they do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do depart the same Court without leave and in the mean time if they be not of the good behaviour &c.
