following to answer unto his said Lordship &c. and that they do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court
thereupon and do depart the same Court without Leave, and in the mean time if they be not of the good
behaviour &c. - At which day here came againe the same Cornelius and Charles Dickerson in their proper
person and unto his said Lordship before acknowledged and thereupon the said Cornelius and
Charles Dickerson as before acknowledged themselves Indebted in debted unto his Lordship the Lord
Proprietary in ten pounds Sterling each to be Levied &c. If it happen that they do not make their
personale appearance before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing
Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer unto his said Lordship &c. and if they
they do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do depart the same Court without
Leave and in the mean time if they be not of the good behaviour &c. -
