ance at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November next —

Thereupon the said Cornelius Dickerson with John Sheldon and John Cope of Somerset County
planters his security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves
indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Cornelius Dickerson in
Twenty pounds Sterling and the said John Sheldon and John Cope in Security in ten pounds
sterling each good and lawfull money of England of their several goods and Chattells Lands and
tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors to be made and levied if it happen
that the said Cornelius Dickerson do and shall not make his personall appearance before the Justi-
ces of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of
November then next following and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning such
things as shall be objected against him on his Lordship behalf and do not stand and abide the
Judgement of the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave and in the mean time
if he is not of his good behaviour —

Likewise the said Cornelius Dickerson is ordered to give security for the payment of the
several Officers fee due by means of the premises aforesaid — Thereupon the said Cornelius Dickerson
with Robert Muhelle his security both present Lord in Court acknowledged themselves indebted
unto his Lordship in one thousand pounds of tobacco each to be levied to the use of the Officers fee
If it happen that the said Cornelius Dickerson do not pay and satisfy to the several Officers
of Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees by means of the premises aforesaid their
lawfull and Right full fees due on the premises, & if for want of legally recovered fee
