

His Lordship's Memorandum: that this day viz. the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1737 came before me the Subj. in  
John Edwards } ben one of his Lordships Justices the peace for the County of Somerset John Edwards  
and his securityes Capt. John Gale and Robert Dashiell and did acknowledge  
them selves to be indebted unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary John Gale in the sum of five  
pounds Sterling money and Robert Dashiell in the sum of five pounds each agreee like money  
af. all to be levied upon their bodies goods and chattels lands and tenements for the use of his Lordships  
the Lord proprietary his heirs and such sees.

The condition of the is such that if the above bound John Edwards do make his personall  
appear, the third Tuesday of August at dividing creek at about three and thorchols to answer unto  
all such matters as on his Lordship's behalf shall be objected against him by Mr. May Beaton  
on Suspicion of hogstealing and to stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereon  
afterwards to wit the third Tuesday of August to wit the sixteenth day of the same month and about  
one thousand seven and thirty seven personally appeared here before his Lordships Justices  
at dividing creek according to the aff. recognizance by him and his security before acknowledged and  
prays that his appearance may be recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged -

Thereupon the same John Edwards appearance is recorded and he and his security dis-  
charged. Whereupon the said John Edwards is ordered to give new security for his appearance  
before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset the third Tuesday of November then  
next to answer as before. Thereupon the said John Edwards with Mathias Gale  
of Somerset County gave his security both present herein Court in their proper persons acknow-  
ledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord proprietary in ten pounds Sterling  
each of their severall goods and chattels lands and tenements to the use of his said Lord-  
ship his heirs and assigns to be made and levied. If it happen that the said John Ed-  
wards do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County  
Court of Somerset to be held at dividing creek the third Tuesday of November then next to an-  
swer unto his Lordship on Suspicion of felony and do not stand and abide the Judgment of  
the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave and in the meantime if he be not  
of the good behaviour &c.
