and eleven pence curr: money of Maryland above said. Eleanor Bowland her heirs Ex: Adm: do
and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the afo^r orphans the afo^r sum of thirty eight
pounds ten shillings and eleven pence curr: Money of Maryland to be paid them according to act of Assembly
and dec^d will when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. Then the above obligation to be
void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue.
