Adm^{ors} or assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves our and either
of our heirs Ex^{ors} and Adm^{ors} for the whole and in the whole Jointly and severally firmly by these presents
sealed with our seals and date this 10th Day of August Ann^o Dom^o 1737 The condition of
the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissary Gen^l hath transmitted unto this Court the
account of the Estate of Isaac Aaronshire dec^d where in it is found that there is due to the above
said orphans the afo^r sum of Eighty ^{five} pounds nine shillings & half penny if there fore the above said
Adam Brevard Isaiah Bredell and James Mumford their heirs Ex^{ors} Adm^{ors} or either of them
do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the afo^r orphans the afo^r sum of eighty five
pounds nine shillings and half penny Equal parts and portions according to Act of Assembly
when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the above obligation to be void and
of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue.

Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing week the third Tuesday
of November then next to answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning of such Matter

do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do depart the same Court
without leave and in the mean time if she be not of the good behaviour towards his said
Lordship.
