and just sum of one hundred and seventy pounds eighteen shillings and one penny to be paid unto these
William Aaronshire Joseph Aaronshire Mary Aaronshire and Rachell Aaronshire their heirs &c.
Adm^r or assignes to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind our selves our and either
of our heirs &c. and Adm^r for the whole and in the whole Jointly and severally firmly by these presents
sealed with our seals and date this 10 Day of August anno Domⁱ 1737. The condition of
the above obligation is as such that whereas the Commissary Gen^r hath transmitted unto this court the
account of the Estate of Isaac Aaronshire dec^d where in it is found that there is due to the above
said orphans the afores^d sum of eighty pounds nine shillings & half penny if therefore the above said
Adam Bradford, Isaiah Bradell and James Mumford their heirs &c. Adm^r or either of them
do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the afores^d orphans the afores^d sum of eighty five
pounds nine shillings and half penny equal parts and portions according to Act of Assembly
when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c. then the above obligation to be void and
of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
