

Justices of your delivery and afterwards to wit at a County Court of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary at Dividing Creek held for the County of Somerset the third Tuesday of November one thousand seven hundred & thirty six before Robert King Esq. and others his associates Justices of his said Lordship sent the said Indictment heretofore of Record, in due form of Law to be determined. Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of the County and that he should take the said James Duffey if he should be found in his County or him should safekeep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March next. And one thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning of the felony and. All which day here before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said James Duffey in his proper person under custody of Joseph Maulester Esq. Sheriff of the County and in whose custody for the said and before that time was committed and to the bar he was led and being instantly asked how he of the felony and in the Indictment and above specified words thereof acquitt himself the same James Duffey says that he is not thereof guilty, and thereof God and Evil put himself upon the Country and William Goldborough Esq. his Lordship's attorney, and who for his said Lordship in this behalf prosecuteth likewise.

Thereupon command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should cause to come here before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court and at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next following twelve Esq. who to recognize because as well as and the same day is given to the said James Duffey under custody of the Sheriff of the County and in the Interim the same James Duffey is committed into the custody of the same Sheriff to be by him safely kept until.

All which day before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said James Duffey under custody of the Sheriff of the County and to the bar here. And in his proper person and the Sheriff sends not there of his will. Therefore as before it is commanded the Sheriff of the County and that he should cause to come here before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following twelve Esq. who to recognize because as well as and the same day is given to the same James Duffey under custody of the Sheriff of the County and in the Interim the same James Duffey is committed into the custody of the same Sheriff to be by him safely kept until.

All which day before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said James Duffey under custody of John Henry Esq. Sheriff of the County and to the
