All which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dwid-
ding Creek came the said Tench Francis by William Goldborough his attorney and the Sheriff of the same County to wit John Hamy Goch. at the same day has returned that he had taken the said Nicholas Fountain whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer unto the said Tench Francis of the said plea as Fountain in the plea ~~led~~ in form following — Somerset sh.
