and at the request and instance of the said Thomas before that time sold and
delivered to him an account unto Court brought and hereto annexed may appear
and being thereof indebted on consideration whereupon himself did affeine
and to the said William then and there faithfully promise that he the said Thomas
the said nine pounds fifteen shillings curr^t money of Virginia of the value of -
when he should be afterwards therof required would faithfully pay and content -
Nevertheless the said Thomas his promise and assumption afo^d informaff
had nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently intenting the said William in
