Douglas his attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas on the twenty fourth day of August Anno Domini seven teen hundred and thirty three at York town at Somerset County afo within the Jurisdiction of this Court was indebted to the said W^m in the sum of nine pounds fifteen shillings Currant money of Virginia of the value of eighteen pounds Curr^t money of Maryland for sundry goods and Merchandise by the said W^m to the said Tho^s and at the request and Instance of the said Thomas before that time sold and delivered as by an account unto Court brought and hereto annexed may appear and being thereof indebted on Consideration thereof upon himself did assume and to the said William then and there faithfully promise that he the said Thomas the said nine pounds fifteen shillings Curr^t money of Virginia of the value afo - when he should be afterwards thereof required would faithfully pay and Content - Nevertheless the said Thomas his promise and assumption afo in form afo had nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the said William in that part to deceive and defraud the said nine pounds fifteen shillings Currant money of Virginia of the value afo to the said William hath not paid but the same to him to pay hitherto hath refused and still doth refuse altho that to do afterwards to wit on the day and year last afo and often afterwards at the County afo and within the afo Jurisdiction the said Thomas by the said William was required whereupon he says he is the worse thirty pounds Curr^t money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit &c
