 Thereupon Francis Porter of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person
 undertakes for the said William Rogers that in case he be non suited in the plea and or otherwise
 Legally sent that then the said William Rogers shall pay the Condemnation of the Court hereupon and all
 costs attending thereon to the said Thomas Lambden or that he the said Francis Porter will do the same

 eth the force and Injury whereof and prayeth Leave thereof to Impare here until the third Tuesday
 of March next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the said William Rogers also
