Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take William Bowen late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Wm Bowen of this County and promise a planter if he should be found in his Bailiwick & him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of August next at one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to satisfy John Dennis Ind. as well a certain debt of fifty five pounds current money of Maryland and five thousand pounds of tobacco which the same John in his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek is levered against him as of three hundred and one pound of tobacco which to the same John in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by reason of the detention of the same debt whereas he is Committed

At which day before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said John Dennis in his proper person and the Sheriff of the County did with his body here at this day he had ready to satisfy &c. as aforesaid he was Committed &c.

Command was given to the Coroners of Somerset County that they should be found in their Bailiwick and him should safe keep so that they might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August next at one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to satisfy Richard Gildart Esq. of seven thousand four hundred and eleven pounds of tobacco which to the same Richard in the same Court before the Justices of his Lordships Court at Dividing Creek are adjudged for his damages which he had by reason of a certain promise and assumption to the same Richard by the said Joseph made and not performed whereas he is Committed &c.

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said Richard Gildart Esq. by William Goldborough his attorney and the Coroners of Somerset County did with Henry Ballard and Wm Lane Gent at the same day here returned that they had taken the said Joseph Mester whose body here at this day they had ready to satisfy &c. as aforesaid they were Committed &c.
