Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County

that he should take Jeremiah Wright late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August ann. Dowd one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to satisfy Francis Allen of one thousand and one hundred and seventy five pounds of tobacco which to the same Francis in his Lordships County Court of Somerset before the Justices there at Dividing Creek were adjudged for his damages which he had by occasion of a certain promise and assignment to the same Francis by the said Jeremiah made and not performed whereof he is contented ~~to~~

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said Francis Allen in his proper person and the said Jeremiah Wright being to the bar now horsed by the Sheriff of the County and by virtue of the writ and to the same Sheriff directed and being by the Court here asked whether he were the same Jeremiah the same person which the said Francis ~~was~~ in the damages and above quoted or not who says that he be Therefore the same Jeremiah Wright is committed to the prison of the Sheriff of the County and that he remain in safe custody until the said Francis of the damages and be satisfied and contented ~~to~~
