At which day here before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset at dividing  
Creek came the said Alexander Bunch by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of the County  
and to wit John Henry Gent at the same day here returned that by virtue of the writ and  
he had caused to be made Twenty Seven pounds and ten pence current money of Maryland  
and seven hundred ninety and five pounds of tobacco of the goods and Chattels of the  
above named Francis Bunch which sum of Twenty Seven pounds ten pence and seven  
hundred and ninety five pounds of tobacco before the Justice above mentioned at the day &  
place above contained he had ready as and it was required &

His Lordship } For as as the said Alexander Chani had not burnt so much tobacco  
Alex. Chani. } as by Law he was obliged to burn but willing to pay his fine for the same  
Wherefore it is considered that the said Alexander Chani pay unto his Lordship the Lord  
Proprietary for his fine for and by evasion of the premises and Twenty Shillings current money  
of Maryland and is ordered to give security for payment of the several Officers their fees  
due by means of the premises and Sir Thomas Norton Knt. Sheriff of Somerset County Gent  
present herein hath undertaken for the same Alex. Chani to pay the several Officers fees due by  
means of the premises and

Ordered that John Scambrough recover against Ezeckiel Wise one hundred and Twenty  
pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance four days as an evidence for the said  
Ezeckiel Wise against Adam Bradford he having made Oath to the same &
