Tuesday of November and Dow. One thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto Tho: Adams of a plea wherefore he the same John with force and arms in and upon the aff Tho: Adams at Somerset County ags in the peace of God and of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary. That now is an assault done made and him the said Thomas Adams did beat wound and wilfully treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him did to the great damage of the same Tho: Adams and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary &c and that show of his should not faille.

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dwidg Creek came the said Thomas Adams by William Gouldsborough his attorney and the Sheriff to wit Joseph Manchester gent at the same day here returned that he had taken the aff John Deal whose body here at that day he had ready to answer unto the aff Thomas Adams of the aff plea as to him it was commanded.

And hereupon the aff Thomas Adams declared against the aff John Deal in the place of inform following. --- Somerset Jr. John Deal late of Somerset County planter was attacked to answer unto Thomas Adams of a plea wherefore he the same John with force and arms in and upon the aff Thomas Adams at Somerset County ags in the peace of God and of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is an assault done made and him the said Thomas Adams did beat wound and wilfully treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him did to the great damage of the same Thomas Adams and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary &c.

And Whereupon the same Thomas by William Gouldsborough his attorney complaineth that the aff John on the second day of August in the year of our Lord God seventeen hundred thirty five with force and arms to wit with sticks clubs and bats at Somerset County ags within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon him the same Thomas in the peace of God and of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is an assault done made and him the Thomas then and there did beat wound and wilfully treat so that of his life it was greatly despaired and other harms to him then and there did to the great damage of the said Thomas and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary &c wherefore he saith that he is the worse and damage hath to the value of three thousand pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings suit &c
