 Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third tuesday of
 March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto the
 Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is of the province of Maryland of
 a plea that he render unto the said Lord Proprietary the sum of ten pounds sterling
 which unto the same Lord Proprietary he oweth and unjustly detaineth &c.

All which day here came William Goldborough Gent who for his said Lordship in this part
 prosecuteth and the Sheriff of the County aforesaid returned here ^{at the same day} that he had taken the aforesaid Charles
 Dickerson whose body here at this day he had ready to answer unto his said Lordship of the
 aforesaid
