Alexander Maddox } Alexander Maddox son of Lazarus Maddox Late of Somerset County decd) an
Orphan above the age of fourteen years came herein Court in his proper person and prays that he may be admitted to Chose a certain Giddion Tillman as his Guardian which is by the same Court unto him granted &c. Thereupon the said Alexander Maddox present herein Court makes Chose of the said Giddion Tillman as his Guardian &c.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that a certain William Fordred deliver up unto the said Guardian all the Estate of the said Alexander Maddox that he hath in his hands and possession both leall and personall peaceably and quietly &c. and that the said Giddion Tillman give Security for to Comply with the Guardian ship aforesaid &c.

Thereupon the said Giddion Tillman with Nicholas Fountain Junr and Joseph Tillman both of Somerset County planters his security present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the said Alexander Maddox in one hundred pounds sterling of good and Lawfull money of England Joyntly and severally of their Bodys goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of the said Alexander Maddox to be made and Levied If it happen that the said Giddion Tillman do not Comply with the Law in Relation to the Guardian ships as aforesaid and do not deliver up unto the said Alexander Maddox all his Estate both real and personall [that he shall take into his hands and possession] peaceably and quietly when ever the same shall be Legally required &c.

His Lordships - } John Evans of Somerset County planter came herein Court in his proper person and
Peter Taylor. } made Complaint to the same Court against a certain Peter Taylor that the said Peter had
threatned him and took the Oath of the peace in Common form, and required the Surety of the peace against the same Peter &c. Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Peter if he to answer &c. And afterwards to wit the fifteenth day of Novemb.
