Ordered that William Bolton overseer of the Road clear further than his Uncle's limits from Baron Creek Mile into the main Road that Leads to Vicuna ferry according to the direction of Mr. Michell Dashiell & said Bolton the said Road to be cleared to the least prejudice of any person or persons whatsoever &c.

Ordered that John Mepink be Overseer and clear a Road from out of the main Road between Little Creek and broad Creek over broad Creek wading place through the Indian fields to Lannons ferry and that William Baker Peter Swiman Daniel Skillee and all other taxables that Live down broad Creek be under the said Overseer in clearing of the said Road &c.

Ordered that Barton Selby be Overseer and clear a Road from Robert Watson's through Mr. William Land's neck of Land, into the main Road (by Littleton's bridge) that Leads down to the ferry the said Road to be cleared according to the direction of Cap^t. William Lane and Robert Watson &c.

Joshua Merrick Constable of Doromoke hundred is appointed by the Court here for the suppression of the Tumultuous meetings of negroes (in the said hundred) according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.
