Thereupon it was Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said
Jane Andrews late of Somerset County Spinster if she should be found in his bailiwick
and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships
County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of
November ann^d Domⁱ. One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Seven to answer unto his said Lord
ship of and concerning her committing of fornication &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c.
And afterward he with the third Tuesday of Novemb. being the fifteenth day of the same Month ann^d Domⁱ.
