

Done One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Seven that same term before the Justices of his Lordship the right honorable the Lord Proprietary at dividing Creek in the same County. Came the said Jane Andrews in her proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and saith that she cannot gainsay but that she is guilty of the premises in the Indictment aforesaid specified above upon her Imposition in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid above against her supposed but desirous to discharge the father of the Child she stands Indicted for. &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood. It is considered by the Justices here that the said Jane Andrews be whipt at the publick whipping post with ten stripes on the bare back well laid on untill the blood appear and that she be taken &c. thereupon as to the Corporall punishment & Command is given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he doe there of Immediate Execution by whipping of the said Jane Andrews at the publick whipping post with ten stripes on the bare back well laid on untill the blood appear and afterwards in the same Court gave said Sheriff and returned that he had done the Execution of Judgment aforesaid as to the Corporall punishment. &c. he was commanded &c. whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Jane Andrews return to the Service of John Worthley her master and that said John Worthley return the said Jane Andrews to the Justices of the County Court or the Sheriff of the County at the Expiration of her Service to be bound to the County of the Several Officers their fees due by Occasion of the premises &c. &c.
