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permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnal knowledge of her body and to beget then and there a bastard child on the body of her the same Margaret to the high displeasure of almighty God to the evil example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government and against the form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided &c. Thereupon it is commanded the then Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Margaret Caldwell if she should be found in his Bailiwick and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer his said Lordship of the fornication &c. whoso of she was Indicted &c.

At which day to wit at a Session of the peace held at dividing Creek in the same County before Robert Knig Gent. and others his associates Justices of his said Lordship the peace in the County &c. to Conserve and also divers Felonies trespasses and other Molefeavances in the same County committed to hear and determine assigned John Henry Gent. Sheriff of the County &c. Returned that the said Margaret Caldwell was not found in his Bailiwick. Therefore Command was again to the said Sheriff as before that he should take the said Margaret Caldwell if he and her keep &c. so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek the third Wednesday of November then next following to answer his said Lordship of the fornication &c. whoso of she was Indicted &c. At which day to wit at a Session of the peace held at dividing Creek in the same County before Robert Knig Gent. and others his associates Justices of his said Lordship the peace in the County &c. to Conserve and also divers Felonies trespasses and other Molefeavances in the same County committed to hear and determine assigned. Came the said Margaret Caldwell in had chearing of the Indictment &c. and said that she cannot gainsay but that she is guilty of the premises in the Indictment &c. specified above upon her Imposed in manner and form as by the Indictment &c. above said her supposed and is willing to pay her fine for the fact &c. Whoso for all and doing all the premises by the Court have seen heard and fully understood. It is Considered that the said Margaret Caldwell pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for her fine by the Court here upon her Imposed for and by reason of the premises &c. whoso of in form &c. she is Convicted thirty Shillings Court money of Maryland to the Use of the County to wend defraying of the said County Charge &c. and that the said Margaret Caldwell be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine &c. &c. Whoso upon the said Margaret Caldwell
