Thereupon a certain John Furlo late of Somerset County blacksmith and Robert Givan late of the Same County Gent both present here in Court in their proper persons undertook for the same Margarett Caldwell and acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in forty pounds Sterling each of their goods and Chattles Lands and tenements to the Use of the Justices of Somerset County Court and their Successors to be made and Levied If it happen that the said Margarett Caldwell her heirs Executors and Administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times here after acquit and save harmless as well the Justices of the County aforesaid and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges troubles and Inconvenience whatsoever for or by reason of the birth-maintenance nourishing and bringing up of the aforesaid Child and of and from all other suits - Charges troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same.

Likewise the said Margarett Caldwell is ordered to give Security for the payment of the severall Officers their fees due on the Indictment aforesaid Thro upon the said John Furlo and Robert Givan both present here in Court as aforesaid acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the severall Officers in the County aforesaid that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Indictment aforesaid in five hundred pound of Tobacco each of their bodies goods or Chattles Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied. In Case the said Margarett Caldwell her heirs Executors or Administrators do not pay and satisfy unto the severall Officers in the County aforesaid their just and rightfull fees or fees on the Indictment aforesaid.
