

County Court and their Successors to be made and Levied If it happen that the said Benj^m Nelson his heirs executors and administrators or any of them do and shall not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit and save harmless as well the Justices of the County aforesaid and their successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges troubles and Incumbrances whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and bringing up the aforesaid Child lately begott on the Body of the aforesaid Mary Glover and of and from all other suits Charges troubles and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same &c.

Likewise the said Benj^m Nelson is ordered to give security for payment of the severall officers fees due on the Indictment aforesaid. Whereupon the said Benjamin Nelson and James Long both present here in Court as aforesaid Acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Severall Officers of Somerset County Court that had a right to any fees or fees on the Indictment aforesaid in One thousand pounds of Tobacco each of their Severall Bodys goods or Chattells Lands or tenements to be made and Levied to the use of the Severall Officer or Officer as aforesaid. In case the said Benjamin Nelson his heirs Executors or administrators do not pay and Satisfie unto the severall officers in the County aforesaid their Just and right full fees or fees on the Indictment aforesaid &c.
