Thereupon Joseph Tillman of Somerset County planter in security present herein Court acknowledged himself indebted unto the severall Officers of Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Indulment ass^{ts} in one thousand pounds of tobacco of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of the severall Officers or officers their heirs or assigns to be made and levied in case the said James Kane his heirs Executors or administrators doe not pay and satisfy unto the severall Officers in the County ass^{ts} their due and right full fee or fees on the Indulment ass^{ts}.
