William Kitchen Isaac Williams Daniel Maddox Lewis Rigby James Strawbridge Thomas Perkins Nehemiah Holland Edward William John Brice Jonathan Bourne Joshua Alderson who to say the truth of and upon the premises aforesaid being elected tried and sworn upon their Oath say that the aforesaid Lydia Coefield is not guilty of the premises in the Indictment aforesaid above specified in manner and form as the aforesaid Special for herself above by pleading alleged — Whereupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen and fully understood — It is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Lydia Coefield of the premises aforesaid be quiet and goe home of without day &c. — Whereupon the said Lydia Coefield is ordered by the Court here to give security for the payment of the severall officers fees due by means of the premises on the Indictment aforesaid. Thereupon John Scarbrough of Somerset County Gent. her security present herein Court acknowledged himself Indebted unto the severall officers of Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Indictment aforesaid in one thousand pounds of tobacco of his body goods or Chattles and Lands or tenements to the use of the severall officer or officers their heirs or assigns to be made and levied In Case the said Lydia Coefield her heirs Executors or Administrators do not pay and satisfie unto the severall officers in the County aforesaid their just and right full fees on the Indictment aforesaid &c. —
