ascertain Mary M^{rs} Farline of the same County in the peace of God and of the said Lord Proprietary then and there being with force and arms a assault did make and the same Mary then and there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of her life it was much decayed and other harms to her then and there did to the great damage of the same Mary and against the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government &c.

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Joan Collings if he to answer &c. And now to witt at this same term held for Somerset County at dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November to witt the fifteenth day of the same month and year One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Seven before the Judges of the said Joan Collings according to a certain Recognizance by her and her family in that part before acknowledged in her proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment &c. and saith that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the trespass and assault &c. in the Indictment &c. Specified above upon her Imposed in manner and form as by the Indictment &c. above against her supposed -- Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood - It is considered by the Court here that the said Joan Collings pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon her Imposed for and by occasion of the trespass and assault &c. whereof in form &c. she is bound to pay current money of Maryland and that the said Joan Collings be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine &c. - Whereupon the said Joan Collings is ordered to give security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due by means of the premises &c. Thereupon James West of Somerset County planter - present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Joan Collings and acknowledged himselfe Indebted unto the severall Officers of Somerset County Court that shall alight to any fee or fees on the Indictment &c. in One thousand pounds of tobacco of his body goods or Chattells Lands or tenements to the use of the severall Officer or Officers their heirs or assigns to be made and Levied In case the said Joan Collings her heirs &c. do not pay and satisfy unto the severall Officers in this County &c. their just & right full fee or fees on the Indictment &c. &c. Whereupon the said Mary M^{rs} Farline present herein Court in her proper person prays the surety of the peace against the said Joan Collings and take the oath of the peace in Common form &c. Whereupon the said Joan Collings is ordered by the Court
