that William Conner late of Centry parish in the County afo<sup>r</sup> planter the first day  
of November and did seventeen hundred thirty and seven at the parish afo<sup>r</sup> in the  
County afo<sup>r</sup> within the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Mary Jones  
of the same County in the peace of God and of the said Lord proprietary then and  
there being with force and arms an assault did make and the same Mary then and  
there did beat wound and evilly treat so that of her life it was much despaired and  
other harms to her then and there did to the great damage of the same Mary and against  
the peace of the said Lord proprietary that now is his good rule and Government  
Thereupon Command was given to the sheriffe of Somerset County that he
