and Thomas Lambden Esq. afterwards to wit the same day before the Justices of the Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the said Sheriff and returned that he had Summoned the aforesaid John Burke Esq. as of he was Commanded & Whereupon came here into Court before the aforesaid Justices as well the aforesaid Thomas Lambden by William Bingham his attorney as the aforesaid John Burke Esq. by George Douglas his attorney and the petition aforesaid being read and heard and the severall allegations as well on the part of the said Thomas Lambden as on the part of said John Burke Esq. and withal the severall Writs first declared upon Oath in relation to his premises and all which matters being duly and naturally Considered and it being made appear to the Satisfaction of the Court here that the aforesaid John Burke Esq. was abused and misused when he lived with the aforesaid Thomas Lambden as servant &c.

Wherefore it is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Thomas Lambden take nothing by his petition aforesaid and that the said John Burke Esq. goeth hence without dayes.
