Whereupon the said John Goldsmith by William Berkingham his attorney Cometh and defendeth the free and Injury wherof and saith that he cannot deny the action of the said James nor can he say but that the writing obligatory is the deed of the said John nor but that he oweth the same James the said Twenty pounds Curr. money of Maryland in manner and form as the said James above against him declared.

Therefore it is considered that the said James Anderson recover against the said John Goldsmith his debt of and his Damages by reason of the detention of the said debt to Seven hundred and fifty three pounds of Tobacco to the said James of his agent by the Court here adjudged with Stay of Execution until the twenty fifth day of December then next following and the said debt in Money &c.

Rt. The Same - Command was given to the sherriffe of Somerset County that he should take Richard Knight late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Richard Knight of Somerset County in the said province of Maryland planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Judges of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at deviding Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to answer unto James Anderson of a plea that he render unto him twenty pounds Curr. money of Maryland which to him he oweth and unjustly detaineth &c and that thereof he should not fail &c.
