And the said Richard Knight by William Buckingham his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and the said James prayeth that the said Richard to his declaration and may answer whereupon the same Richard hath till Thursday the third day of this term to him given by the Court here to answer &c. and the same Richard at the same day solemnly called to answer Cometh not nor the same attorney of the said Richard & for the same Richard nothing there of saith in bar or preclusion of the action of the said James by which the same James remaineth there of against him undefended &c.

Therefore it is considered that the said James Anderson recover against the said Richard Knight his debt and his damages occasioned by detention of the same debt to seven hundred and forty one . . . . . pounds of tobacco to the same James of his apent by the Court here adjudged with stay of execution until the twenty fifth day of December then next following and the said do as in mercy &c.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Wouney M. Lemmey late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at deviding Creek in the same County the third Wednesday of November Ann'd Don'd one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to answer unto Martin fenton of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. and that thereof he should not fail &c. and hereupon the said Martin fenton by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney declared against the said Wouney M. Lemmey in the plea of in form following vizt Somerset County vs Wouney M. Lemmey late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Martin fenton of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c.

And Whereupon the said Martin by Robert Jenchins Henry his attorney complains that whereas the said Wouney M. Lemmey after the first day of may Ann'd Don'd seven hundred and five (or will) on the second day of August one thousand seven hundred thirty and
