All which day before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing creek Cometh the afo Joshua Caldwell by his attorney afo and the Groners to wit William Lane and Henry Ballard Gent. Groners of the County of Somerset afo Returned a certain Inquisition before them at dividing creek at the Court house in the County afo the fifteenth day of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six by the oath of honest and Lawfull men of their County taken by which it is found that the afo Joshua hath sustained damages by Occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption of beyond his Cost and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to twenty three pounds twelve shillings and four pence Court money of Maryland and for those Cost and Charges to one pound of tobacco.

Therefore it is considered that the afo Joshua Caldwell recover against the afo Joseph McClester his damages afo by the Inquisition afo found also. Eleven hundred and Eighty One ¹¹⁵⁹ - - - - - pounds of tobacco for his Cost and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to the same Joshua by the Court here at his request Increase a Judge with certain damages in the whole do amount to twenty three pounds twelve shillings and four pence Court money of Maryland and: Eleven hundred and Eighty two ¹¹⁶⁰ - - - - - pounds of tobacco with stay of Execution untill the first day of May then next following and the afo Joseph in mercy &c
