Therefore it is considered by consent of the parties aforesaid that the aforesaid John Lewis recover against the aforesaid William Kellher his damages aforesaid to the aforesaid thirty two pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence half penny Sterling by the same William in form afft acknowledged as also from hundred and thirty six pounds of tobacco for his loss and charges afft to the same John at his request by the Court now here of the aforesaid of the parties afft adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to thirty two pounds thirteen Shillings and five pence half penny Sterling and from hundred and thirty six pounds of tobacco with stay of payment till the first day of January then next following and if aforesaid William in mercy

Thos John Caldwell command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County for James Townsend that he should take James Townsend Sale of Somerset County County planter if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November and Dated One thousand seven hundred and thirty Seven to answer unto John Caldwell of a plea of trespass upon the said James Townsend and herewith the said John Caldwell declared against the aforesaid James Townsend in the plea afft in form following videlicet

Somerset sh. James Townsend late of Somerset County planter was attacked to answer unto John Caldwell of a plea of trespass upon the said James Townsend

And Whereupon the said John Caldwell by Geo Douglas his attorney complains that whereas the said James after the first day of May and Dated seventeen hundred and five to witt on the eighteenth day of November and Dated seventeen hundred thirty and six at the County aforesaid did make his certain note in writing called a promissory note with his proper hand subscribed bearing date the day and year last aforesaid and the same note to the said John Caldwell then and there did deliver by which note the said —

James oblige himself or promise to pay unto the said John eleven hundred and forty pounds of tobacco either in pork at pound for pound or in curr. money of Maryland at twelve shillings and six pence per hundred on or before the first day of March next ensuing
