or tender his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sherife of the County and there to remain until the same Judgment be fully satisfied or that he the said Abraham Owen will do the same for him &c.

And the aforesaid John Bishop by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney Cometh and defendeth the force and Injury whenst. and saith that he did not assume upon himself in manner and form as the said David Wilson above against ^{him} hath complained and of this he puts himself upon the Country and the said David in like manner. And afterwards the same Day the said John Bishop by his attorney afo^{re} present herein Court Relinquisheth his verification afo^{re} by him above pretend: ed saith that he cannot deny the action afo^{re} of the said David nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said David above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same David by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same John saith and acknowledgeth that the said David hath sustained Damages by occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part assessed to four pounds Seventeen Shillings Curr^{nt} money of Maryland and not more and because the said David deny's not this but the same allegation believeth to be true prays Judgment for those Damages above acknowledged together with his Costs & Charges afo^{re} to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties afo^{re} it is considered that the said David Wilson recover against the said John Bishop his Damages afo^{re} to the said four pounds Seventeen Shillings Curr^{nt} money of Maryland by the same John in form afo^{re} acknowledged as also 306 Three hundred and Twenty Eight pounds for his Costs and Charges afo^{re} to the 328 same David at his request by the Court now here of the afo^{re} of the parties afo^{re} adjudged which certain Damages in the whole amounts to four pounds Seventeen Shillings Curr^{nt} money of Maryland and Three hundred and Twenty Eight pounds of Tobacco with stay of Execution until the Twenty fifth day of December then next following and said John Merrey Sen
