According to Law and that by Good and Lawfull men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the persons or persons in whose hands you make the same attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court to be held as aforesaid to shew cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods chattles & rights or Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be condemned and execution thereof had and made according to act of assembly in such case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall execute this writt that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and have you then and there this writt Witness John Smith Gent. one of our Justices of our said Court the nineteenth day of August in the twenty fourth year of our Dominion &c. And Done one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven
