Thomas Bluett of the same County Gent of a plea that he render unto him twenty six pounds Court money of America which to him he oweth and unjustly detaineth. And whereupon the same Thomas by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney saith that whereas the afd John the nineteenth day of July in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred thirty and six at Somerset County afd within the Jurisdiction of this Court by his certain writing obligatory did acknowledge himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said Thomas in the afd twenty six pounds Court money of America to be paid to the same Thomas <sup>whom his bonds</sup> be thereunto requested Nevertheless the said John altho' often thereunto requested the afd twenty six pounds Court money afd to the same Thomas he hath not as yet rendered but the same to him hitherto to render hath denied and still doth refuse and deny wherefore he saith that he saith is the worse and hath damage to the value of thirty pounds Court money of the province of Maryland and thereof he brings suit & doth bring here into Court the writing afd which the debt afd in form afd doth testify the date whereof is the same day and year afd. A Copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the debt with the writ afd according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

All which day herebefore the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at dividing Creek came the afd Thomas Bluett by his attorney afd and the sheriff to wit John Henry Gent at the same day here returned that he had taken the afd John Borman whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the afd Thomas Bluett of the afd plea as to him it was commanded and the same sheriff further returned that he had served the same John Borman with a Copy of the declaration afd according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

And the aforesaid John Borman in his proper person Cometh and defendeth the force and injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action afd of the afd Thomas Bluett nor but that <sup>the writing obligatory is the deed of the same John nor but</sup> he oweth the afd Thomas the afd Twenty Six pounds Court money of America in manner & form as the afd Thomas above against him hath declared &c.

Therefore it is considered that the afd Thomas Bluett recover against the afd John Borman his debt afd and his damages by occasion of the detaining of the same debt
