Dine Jonathan Bowdoy Joshua Atkinson John Merrill who to say the truth of the premises,  
aforesaid being Elected byed and Sworn upon their Oath say that the aforesaid Benjamin Henderson did  
assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid William Conner above against him both  
Complaints and assessed the damages of the aforesaid William by reason of the non performance of  
the promise and assumption aforesaid beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that  
part assessed to four pounds Eight Shillings Curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland and for those  
Costs and Charges to one pound of Tobacco.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid William Conner recover against the aforesaid  
Benjamin Henderson his damages aforesaid by the Jurors aforesaid in sum aforesaid assessed as also  
same Williams by the Court now here of his aforesaid of Increase adjudged which certain damages  
in the whole amounts to four pounds Eight Shillings Curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland and

in Cash to contain the same which he owes and unjustly detains &c.
