And the aforesaid William Porter by William Speerhingham his attorney Cometh and defendeth
the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid
Alexander nor but that the writing obligatory aforesaid is the deed of the same William Porter
nor but that he oweth the same Alexander the aforesaid sum of fifty five pounds eight
shillings and six pence Court money of Maryland in manner and form as the aforesaid
Alexander above against him declared &c. Therefore it is considered that the
aforesaid Alexander Bunck recover against the aforesaid William Porter his debt aforesaid and
his damages by occasion of the detaining of the same debt to Two hundred & ninety
four pounds of tobacco to the same Alexander
of his aforesaid by the Court here adjudged and the aforesaid William in mercy &c.

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Qd. The Same . . . } Somerset sh. William Gray late of Somerset County plan-
ter otherwise called William Gray of Somerset County planter
was summoned to answer unto Alexander Bunck of a plea that
he render unto him fifty five pounds eight shillings and six pence Court money of
Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detaineth &c.

And Whereupon the said Alexander by George Douglas his attorney says -
that whereas the said William on the seventeenth day of March Anno Domini
MDCCXXXVI at the County aforesaid by his certain writing obligatory which the said Alex-
ander sealed at with the seal of the said William here into Court Court being whose date
is the day and year aforesaid did acknowledge himself to be held and firmly bound unto the
said Alexander in the said fifty five pounds eight shillings and six pence Court money
of Maryland to be paid to the said Alexander his heirs Executors or assigns when he
should be afterwards thereto required Nevertheless the said William the said fifty
five pounds eight shillings and six pence to the said Alexander hath not rendered but
that to doe hitherto hath denied and still doth deny and unjustly detain altho. thereto
