Therefore it is considered that the as^t Alexander Bunckle recover against the as^t William Gray his debt as^t and his damages by occasion of the detaining the same debt to: Two hundred and Seventy Six 254 pounds of tobacco to the same Alexander of his assent by the Court here adjudged and the as^t William in mercy &c.

Command was given to the sherriffe of Somerset County that he should take Whixham Crapper late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bail: Lywich and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at deciding free in the same County the third tuesday of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six to answer unto Robert Bolton of a plea that he render unto him three pounds one shilling and three pence Curr. money of Maryland and two hundred and forty pounds of tobacco which to him he oweth and unjustly detaineth &c. All which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at deciding free came the as^t Robert Bolton by his attorney as^t and the sherriffe to witt John Henry Gent. at the same day here returned that he had laden the as^t Whixham Crapper whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the as^t Robert Bolton of the as^t plea as to him it was committed Whereupon came here into Court a certain Thomas Souiter of Somerset County planter and undertook
