At which day here before his Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Ann Draper as the aforesaid Robert Given by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Robert Given prays further Leave thereof to Imparle here until the third Tuesday of June then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Ann here also &c.

At which day here before his Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Ann Draper as the aforesaid Robert Given by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Robert Given prays further Leave thereof to Imparle here until the third Tuesday of August then next following and hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Ann here also &c.

At which day here before his Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Ann Draper as the aforesaid Robert Given by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Robert Given prays further Leave thereof to Imparle here until the third Tuesday of November then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Ann here also &c.

At which day here before his Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Ann Draper as the aforesaid Robert Given by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the same Robert Given as before defendeth the free and Injury when &c. and prays the bearing of the writing obligatory aforesaid and it
