I Item I will that my said young wife shall have all her Breadcorn for her own family use ground Toll free during her widowhood at that mill of Cedar Creek aforesaid. I Item I will and ordain that if any of my Children either sons or daughters shall prove obstinate and contrary against their mothers will they may be hereby disinherited of their ^{share} dividend of their part and dividuall of my moveable estate. I Item I will and ordain and do hereby constitute my said young wife Anne Draper to be executrix of this my last will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannull all and every other former testaments wills Legacies and Bequests Executrix and Executrix's by me in any wise before named willed or Bequeathed relaying allowing and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament.
