eth and unjustly detaineth &c

And Whereupon the said Thomas Fletcher by William Beckingham his attorney saith that —
whereas the afd: Thomas Lambden the second day of february Anno Dom: seventeen hundred thirty
and six at Somerset County afd: by his certain writing obligatory had granted himself to be bound unto
the afd: Thomas Fletcher in the afd: sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of great Britain to be
paid unto the said Thomas Fletcher when thereof afterwards he should be required. Nevertheless the
afd: Thomas Lambden altho' often required the afd: sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of
great Britain or any penny thereof unto the afd: Thomas Fletcher hath not paid but that unto him
hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse and still doth refuse to the damage of the same
Thomas Fletcher one hundred and fifty pounds sterling money of great Britain and thereupon he
bringeth suit &c And doth bring hereinto Court the writing obligatory afd: which the debt afd: in form
afd: testifies the date whereof is the same day and year afd: — — — — — George & John Doe

And the aforesaid Thomas Lambden by William Goldborough his attorney saith and defend-
eth the force and injury when &c and saith that he cannot deny the action afd: of the afd: Thomas Fletcher
nor but that the writing obligatory afd: is the deed of the same Thomas Lambden nor but that he oweth the
same Thomas Fletcher the afd: one hundred pounds sterling money of great Britain in manner and form
as the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher above against him declared.....

Therefore it is considered that the afd: Thomas Fletcher recover against the afd: Thomas Lambden his
debt afd: and his damages by reason of his detaining of the same debt to Two hundred and fifty Nine
pounds of tobacco to the same Thomas Fletcher of his afd: by the Court here adjudged and the afd: Thomas
Lambden in Money &c
