

March Court — 1736 — 16

WB Thomas Fletcher of Somerset County/ Thomas Lambden Late of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Merchant otherwise called Thomas Lambden of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Merchant was summoned to answer unto the Revd Thomas Fletcher of all hallows parish in the County and province of Cork of a plea that he render unto him the sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of great Britain which unto him he owe: eth and unjustly detaineth him.

And Whereupon the said Thomas Fletcher by William Beckingham his attorney saith that — whereas the aforesaid Thomas Lambden the second day of February Anno Domini seventeen hundred thirty and six at Somerset County aforesaid by his certain writing obligatorie had granted himself to be bound unto the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher in the aforesaid sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of great Britain to be paid unto the said Thomas Fletcher when thereof afterwards he should be required. Nevertheless the aforesaid Thomas Lambden altho often required the aforesaid sum of one hundred pounds sterling money of great Britain or any penny thereof unto the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher hath not paid but that unto him hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse and still doth refuse to pay the damage of the same Thomas Fletcher one hundred and fifty pounds sterling money of great Britain and thereupon he bringeth suit. And doth bring hereinto Court the writing obligatorie of which the debt aforesaid informeth testifies the date whereof is the same day and year aforesaid. Glodger Dr John Doe

And the aforesaid Thomas Lambden by William Golds brought his attorney (smeth and defend) eth the force and injury when he and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher nor but that the writing obligatorie aforesaid is the deed of the same Thomas Lambden nor but that he owe the same Thomas Fletcher the aforesaid One hundred pounds Sterling money of great Britain in manner and form as the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher above against him declared.....

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Thomas Fletcher recover against the aforesaid Thomas Lambden his debts and damages by reason of his detaining of the same debt to Two hundred and forty Nine pounds of tobacco to his said Thomas Fletcher of his aforesaid by the court here adjudged and the aforesaid Thomas Lambden in Maryland.
