Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Nathaniel Carrington take nothing by his writ of but for his false clamour be thereof in Merit and that the ^{af} Thomas Strow go thereof without Day &c. and further it is considered that the ^{af} Thomas Strow recover against the ^{af} Nathaniel Carrington Three hundred and Seventy Eight pounds of costs for his costs and Charges by him about his defence in that part sustained to the ^{af} Thomas by the Court now heard of his appeal according to the form of the statute in such case lately made and provided adjudged and that the ^{af} Thomas have thereof Execution &c. &c.

Maulemney by George Douglas his attorney and the sherriffe to witte Joseph M^{re} Cester Gent. at the same day here returned that he had taken the ^{af} John Evans whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the ^{af} Wm. Maulemney whereof the ^{af} plea as to him it was commanded. - And whereupon the same John Evans puts in his place William Berknigham Gents attorney at Law against the ^{af} Wm. Maulemney of the ^{af} Plea. Whereupon at the request of the parties day is given to the parties ^{af} here before his Lordships Justices at deviding Creek ^{until} the third Tuesday of August then next following to be in the same State as at present saving to the parties &c.
