And the afo William Maclemmey in his own proper person cometh and defendeth the force and Injury when G. J. and saith that he cannot deny the action afo of the afo Thomas Nevell nor but that he did assure upon himself in manner and form as the afo Thomas Nevell above against him hath complained and as to the damages of the same Thomas by him by occasion of the premises in that part the same William Maclemmey saith and acknowledgeth that the afo Thomas hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part ~~in that part~~ apposed to thirty pounds seventeen shillings and two pence sterling and not more and because the afo Thomas deny's not this but the same allegation believes to be true pray Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and Charges afo to him to be adjudged

Therefore by Consent of the parties afo it is considered that the afo Thomas Nevell recover against the afo William Maclemmey his damages afo to the afo to thirty pounds seventeen shillings and two pence ^{sterling} by the same William in form afo acknowledged as also:

10 pounds of tobacco for his costs and Charges afo to the same Thomas at his request by the Court now here of the assent of the parties afo adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to thirty pounds

173 Seven teen Shillings and two pence Sterling and pounds of tob^o. with Stay of Execution until the twentieth day of December next following and the afo William in Money &c.
