To the Worshipfull Justices of Somerset County as a Court of Equity the petition of Patrick Daley humbly sheweth that some time past one Edward Harper prosecuted an Action on the case against your petitioner alledging that your petitioner has prosecuted against the same Edw: Harper an Indictment for an assault and Battery to the great damage of the same Edward as was therein alledged on the tryal whereof the same Edward recovered a verdict and Judgment against your petitioner for nine hundred pounds of tobacco or some other sum of tobacco within the Cognizance of this Court for damages by Occasion of the same premises your petitioner further sheweth that he is advised the verdict and Judgment af: are contrary to the Rules of equity and good Conscience your petitioner therefore humbly praye your worships will proceed to enquire into the same as a Court of equity and that Subpena may be issue against the said Edw: Harper to answer the premises af: and that your worships will make such order and decree therein as shall be agreeable to equity and good Conscience and he will praye - - -

Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should cause to come the said Edw: Harper if he be answerable and afterwards to wit the Eighteenth day of November anno: Dom: One thousand and thirty five before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now here hold at Dividing Beck in the same County Cometh the said Edward Harper by George Douglas his attorney and praye Leave thereof to Impare hereunto the third Wednesday of March anno: Dom: One thousand Seven hundred & thirty five and he hath it and the same day is given to the af: Patrick here also & - - -

At which day here came againe as well the af: Patrick Daley by William Beckingham his attorney as the af: Edward Harper by his attorney aforesaid and whereupon the same Edward Harper prayeth
