and six pence like money of the goods and Chattles of John Holland
then and there being found then and there feloniously did ^{take} steal and bear
away contrary to the peace of the said Lord proprietary that now is his
good rule and Government and against the form of the act of assembly in
such case lately made and provided &c.

And thereupon at the same day before his Lordships Justices of assize and goal ^{delivery} at ^{Creek} dividing
Cometh the said James Duffey under Custody of Joseph Maister Gent. Sheriff of the County
of in whose Custody before that time for the cause aforesaid was committed to the bar here
and in his proper person and being instantly asked how he of the felony aforesaid
in the Indictment aforesaid above specified will ^{thereof} acquitt himself saith that he
is not ^{thereof} guilty and thereupon of good and will he puts himself upon
the Country, and William Goldsbrough Gent. who for his said Lordship in that part follow-
eth in like manner - and thereupon the said James Duffey is committed into the Custody of
the said Sheriff Thoro to remain ^{there} Which same Indictment the said Justices of
his said Lordships of assize and goal delivery afterwards to wit at a County
Court of his said Lordships held for Somerset County at deviding Creek
in the same County the third Tuesday of November Anno Domini one
thousand seven hundred and thirty six before Robert King Gent. and
others his associates ^{Justices} of his said Lordships for the County aforesaid by ^{their} own
proper hands delivered herein Court of Record in due form of Law to be
determined - Thereupon Command was given to the sheriffs of
the County aforesaid that he should take the said James Duffey if he should
be found in his bailiwicks and him should safe keep so that he might have
his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to
be held at deviding Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following
to answer unto his said Lordships of the felony aforesaid in the Indictment
aforesaid mentioned &c. At which day here before his Lordships Justices at deviding
Creek came again as well the said William Goldsbrough who be as the said James Duffey
