as afo.) amounting to three pounds ten Shillings Curr. money of Maryland. And that
the afo. James Duffey stand in and upon the pillory immediately at
deciding heere in the County afo. the space of a quarter of an hour and
that the said James Duffey be whipt at the public whipping post
ten stripes on the bare back well laid on untill the blood appear and
that the same ^{James} Duffey be taken off. And thereupon as to the Corpor-
:all punishment afo. Command is given to the sherriffe of the County afo.
that he do thereof Immediate execution according to the Judgment
afo. rendered by setting the same James Duffey in and upon the pill-
:ory one quarter of an hour and by whipping him at the public
whipping post with ten stripes on the bare back well laid on untill
the blood appear and afterwards in the same Court came the said sherriffe
and made return that he had done the execution of the Judgment afo. ^{and the Corporal punishment} that he
was Commanded. and thereupon the said James Duffey present herein
Court in his proper person is committed into the custody of the sherriffe
of the County afo. thereto remain untill the said James Duffey be disch-
