Somerset County 1<sup>st</sup> By Virtue of a Commission to us directed Baring  
date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1737 to examine evidences in relation to the  
bounds of a tract of Land called Parkers adventure belonging to a certain  
Samuel Parker in the County and lying in an Indian town -  
we the subscribers being qualified have appointed a day as the Law directs  
and have met on the said Land and caused to come before us this 2<sup>d</sup> day of Novem-  
ber 1737 Mathew Rayn aged sixty one years of age or thereabouts being  
sworn on the holy evangelist of almighty God (saith) that John Parker  
the father of Sam. Parker told him the deponent that the Live oak  
stood in a Glade near Hopstone Hill in the afo<sup>r</sup> Indian Town was the  
first boundary of Parkers Adventure but since the afo<sup>r</sup> Parker telling  
him the deponent the afo<sup>r</sup> Live oak hath been blowed down so that there is  
nothing standing but the stump with three notches on three sides and that  
the deponent to the best of his knowledge Really believes it to be the  
very tree and further saith not this deposition taken before us the day  
and year above -
