Ordered that Thomas Talbot Recover against William Conner Ninety pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance three days as an evidence on behalfe of the said William Conner against Benjamin Henderson he having made oath to the same &c.

Ordered that Isaac Marshale Recover against William Crapper One hundred and Twenty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance four days as an evidence on behalfe of the same William Crapper at Suit of Robert Bolton. he having made oath to the same &c.

for Richard Brooks.

Command was given to the Justices of Somerset County that they should take Richard Brooks late of Somerset

County planter otherwise called Richard Brooks if he should be found in their bailiwick and him should safe keep so that they might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November and Term One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Seven to answer unto John Henry Gent. Sheriff of the County of a plea that he tender him two hundred Sixty six pounds Curr. money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detaines &c.

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came the aff John Henry by George Douglas his attorney and the Crowners to wit William Lane and Henry Ballard Gent. at the same day here returned that they had taken the aff Richard Brooks whose body here at this day they had ready to answer the aff John Henry of the aff plea as to him it was Commanded &c. Afterwards to wit the same third Tuesday of November and Term One thousand seven hundred and thirty seven at Dividing Creek Cometh the aff Richard Brooks in his proper person and the aff John Henry then and there his witt aff against the aff Richard did not prosecute with effect but
